### NOTE ON ASH WEDNESDAY Distribution of Ashes in Time of Pandemic


*The priest says the prayer for blessing the ashes. He sprinkles the ashes with holy water, without saying anything. Then he addresses all those present and only once says the formula as it appears in the Roman Missal, applying it to all in general, "Repent, and believe in the gospel" or "Remember that you are dust, and to dust you shall return."*

*The priest then cleanses his hands, puts on a face mask and distributes the ashes to those who come to him. The priest takes the ashes and sprinkles them on the head of each one without saying anything.*

**Week of February 21:** To grow in faith, live the gospel, have gratitude for what the Lord has done for us

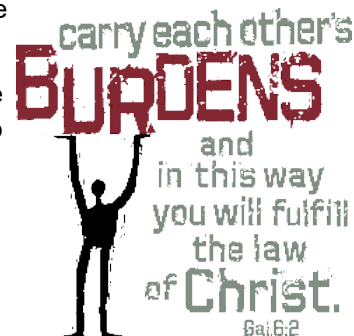
**Week of February 28:** To listen with an open heart and mind; Listen to each other; Listen to God; Build a world of justice, peace and mercy
