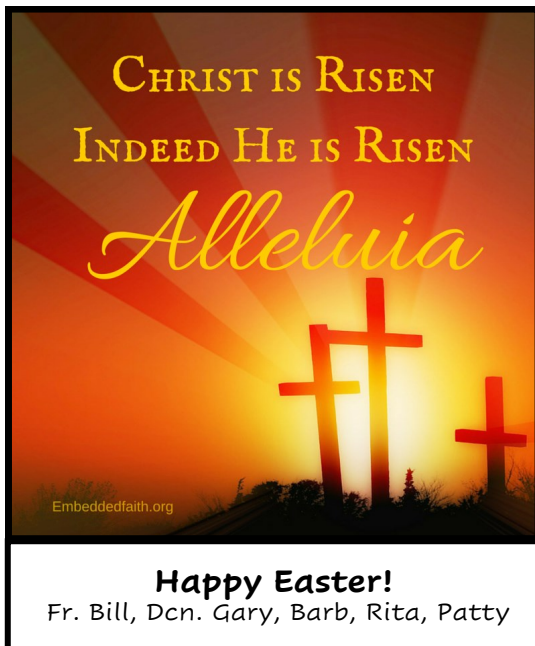


Thoughts for Today's Readings

To the Point: Even on Easter Sunday, the disciples do not quite get it. Jesus' resurrection is still hidden in mystery. There are hints here—an empty tomb and burial cloths. But Mary Magdalene misreads the empty tomb; she assumes that someone has taken Jesus' body. The fulness of what has happened has yet to be revealed. So it is for you, who live in the light of the resurrection and yet still experience pain and suffering and loss. Easter joy is not always accessible in its fulness, but we know there is more there than we can see.

1. The disciples of this gospel do not encounter the risen Jesus but rather see hints of what has happened. What hints and whispers of the resurrection do you see in your own life?
2. Even faced with the empty tomb, Mary Magdalene and Peter and the other disciple need to grow in their understanding of Jesus' death-defying work. How do you still need to grow in your understanding of God's work in your life?

"He is not here."
Mark 16:6

Dear Brothers and Sisters in the Lord,

Most Christian churches make the claim that you can find the Lord here, but there is one very important church that makes the opposite claim, "He is not here." This is the Church of the Holy Sepulchre, located in Jerusalem over the site of the Crucifixion and tomb of our Lord Jesus.

Even to this day, pilgrims to this church can enter the tomb and see that it is empty. There are gold letters above the slab where His body was buried that proudly proclaim, "He is risen; He is not here" (Mark 16:6).

These were the words that the angel addressed to the women who were coming to the tomb to anoint the Lord's body. They were expecting to find the body of the Lord in the place where He was buried. These women were among the few of our Lord's loyal followers who remained with Him, even to the foot of the Cross. They knew which tomb to go to, for they witnessed His burial (see Mark 15:40-41 and Mark 15:47).

They were the first witnesses to the Lord's Resurrection. They were the first to rejoice in the great news that Christ has conquered death.

It is natural to question, where were the other disciples? The Gospel of Luke tells us two of them were fleeing Jerusalem, and the Gospel of John tells us that the others were hiding in the upper room. Fear kept them from going to the Lord's tomb. Fear kept them from hearing the Good News of the Resurrection. But even if they, somehow, overcame their fear, they would not have been able to find the tomb. They were not at the foot of the Cross, and they did not witness where the Lord was buried. So, they would not have known where to find Him.

We see that there is a connection between the Cross and the Resurrection. Those who followed the Lord, even to the foot of the Cross, are the first to receive the Good News of the Resurrection. They were the first to see that the tomb was empty. This is an important lesson for us. Those who embrace the crosses of their lives, often experience the greater joy at Easter. If we run from the crosses that life brings our way, we are also running away from our share in the Resurrection.

The celebration of Easter is that joyful confidence, and bold proclamation, that God transforms the darkness of Good Friday into the light of Easter morning. It is the steady belief that God transforms the darkness of our sorrows into the joy that the world cannot take away.

"So also you have sorrow now,
but I will see you again,
and your hearts will rejoice,
and no one will take your joy from you."

Overview of Finance Council Responsibilities:

- Oversees the accounting system for the parish and the keeping of financial records
- Oversees the creation of an annual budget in accord with the mission, goals, priorities and plans
- Provides an analysis of income and expenditures in comparison to budget projections
- Assures that a complete and understandable annual financial report is made to parishioners
- Ensures that financial procedures for internal controls are in place for the oversight of cash and financial accounts
- Makes recommendations for the generation of revenue in support of the overall mission of the parish
- Oversees and coordinates all fundraising within the parish in accord with Church Canon Law & the Diocesan proxy process
- Monitors investments
- Oversees the day-to-day and long-range maintenance of parish buildings and grounds
- Monitors the observance of diocesan personnel policies pertaining to labor and the conduct of business in employment and compensation of workers

Overview of Parish Council Responsibilities:

- Works in collaboration with the pastor and staff to discern and carry out the will of God for our parish now and into the future
- Works with the pastor, staff, committees, and parish organizations for the common good and mission of the parish
- Assists in the development of parish policies and strategies to address concerns and needs
- Collaborates with pastor to assess needs, establish goals and priorities and review the overall operation of the parish for the previous year

Membership Terms (for both Councils):

- Member at Large—Serve for a three year term, renewable once
- Secretary & Treasurer Trustee—Serve for a two year term, renewable twice (elected position)
 - Treasurer Trustee—a member of the finance council
 - Secretary Trustee—a member of the parish council

Treasurer Trustee

- Serves as member of Finance Council
- Assists with review and adherence to Parish Financial Instructions
- Assists with overseeing the coordination and maintenance of accurate and detailed accounts of all receipts and disbursements of parish funds
- Assists in the collection of parish contributions and special collections
- Assists in management of parish investments
- Assures timely preparation and distribution of financial reports to the parish and the diocese
- Assures that records of all parish property, property tax documents and parish inventory are maintained

Secretary Trustee

- Serves as member of Pastoral Council
- Assists with ensuring the pastoral care of the parish
- Ensures the parish annual meeting is held
- Assists in taking and keeping minutes of all meetings of the corporate board of directors
- Attends to corporate notices and correspondence
- Assists to ensure that proxy documents are recorded and filed.
- Ensures that all corporate reports as prescribed by federal, state, local, and diocesan authorities are prepared and filed
- Assists in development of parish policies and strategies to address the needs and mission of the church
