# **WHAT TO EXPECT WHEN ATTENDING**

## **GENERAL INFORMATION**

### **Attendance:**

- No reservations are needed
- Social distancing will be practiced; Families who arrive together—may sit together. Plan to meet your group in the parking lot, if necessary.
- Capacity is limited only when social distancing can no longer be safely observed

### **Upon Arrival:**

- Enter through the main doors at church
- All members of the faithful will need to bring and wear their own appropriate mask/face covering
- Temperatures are no longer being taken

### **Mass will Look Different:**

- Physical greetings will be omitted
- Music: Per the Guidelines from the Diocese of Green Bay ... Full choirs will not be utilized but rather continue to use a cantor and a musician for the celebration of the liturgy. Congregational singing may be done with face coverings.
- A single communion line will be formed in the center aisle maintaining 6 ft spacing
- The suspension of the distribution of the Precious Blood remains in effect
- Collection baskets will not be passed—you are encouraged to give in a common basket upon your arrival or departure from Mass

### **Extra Sanitization will be in Place:**

- Hand sanitizer will be available at the entrances
- Frequently touched surfaces will be cleaned between Masses, including but not limited to pews, kneelers, and door handles

## **HOLY THURSDAY**

- The Ritual of Washing Feet will be omitted
- At the end of the Mass of the Lord's Supper the procession is omitted and the Blessed Sacrament will be kept in the tabernacle

## **GOOD FRIDAY**

- The veneration of the cross should NOT be done by touch, especially by a traditional kiss. A bow of the head would be appropriate.

## **HOLY SATURDAY (EASTER VIGIL)**

- The Blessing of the Fire will take place at the back of church with the faithful remaining in the pews
- The use of small, lit candles by the faithful will be omitted

## **EASTER VIGIL OR EASTER SUNDAY MASS**

- Upon arrival Ushers will direct the faithful to the pews in order to seat the greatest number of people in the available space while maintaining safety guidelines
