

Holy Trinity Parish and St. Gregory Parish Updates as of May 26, 2020

PALM DISTRIBUTION (Pentecost Sunday)

Father Tony will privately bless the palms on Friday, May 29. You may pick up palms during open church hours on Saturday, May 30 or Sunday, May 31. They will also be available at the Communion Services.

COMMUNION SERVICES (Beginning Pentecost Weekend - May 30 & 31) (NOT MASS)

Schedule: Saturday - 5pm St. Gregory Parish
Sunday - 8am Holy Trinity Parish
Sunday - 10am St. Gregory Parish
Sunday - 7pm Holy Trinity Parish

Guidelines:

- Communicants may not stop or stay at church prior to or after receiving.
- Communicants are encouraged to receive in the hand.
- People age 65 or above and anyone with compromised immunity are at an increased risk. Attendance is at individual discretion.
- Temperatures will be taken as you enter church. If the temperature is 100.4 or higher, the person should go home and not participate in parish Communion Service.
- Everyone in attendance is required to wear a mask. You are encouraged to bring your own. However, a mask will be provided if needed.
- Social distancing guidelines should be followed - staying 6 feet apart.
- Limit of 9 people in church, this includes Father Tony and volunteers.

Upon Arrival:

- At St. Gregory:
 - Please wait in your vehicle until instructed by a volunteer to enter church. Entry will be through the main doors only (west side).
- At Holy Trinity:
 - Enter the church at the main doors. Temperatures will be taken and you will be instructed where to proceed.
- Communicants outside church should observe social distance.

Communion Procedure:

- Hand sanitizer will be available at the entrances of the churches.
- One communion line will be formed in the center aisle.
- Floor markings will indicate proper social distancing - 6 feet apart. Members of the same household may enter together but asked to observe social distancing forming a single line once inside the church (Husband and wife; Parents and children; etc)
- Communicants should remove the mask by the ear loops to receive, hold the mask by the loop(s) on your left fingers, freeing the right hand to consume the Precious Body.
- The Precious Body must be consumed in the presence of the minister.

- If you have difficulty walking or standing, please use the designated chairs/pews upon entering church. Father Tony will bring communion to you.
- Communicants may not stay at church after receiving communion.
- Private prayer may take place in your car or at home.
- Exit through the designated door.
 - At St. Gregory - north door by the chapel
 - At Holy Trinity - east door towards parking lot
- Offertory baskets will be available at the entrance and exit doors.

WEEKDAY MASSES (Beginning June 2)

- Holy Trinity - 8:15am Tuesday and Wednesday
- St. Gregory - 8:15am Thursday and Friday (no 6pm Mass on Thursday)
- Masses at St. Gregory Parish will be held in the main church - not the chapel.
- 8 or fewer members of the faithful will be able to attend at a time.
- Temperatures will be taken and masks are required.
- Only Precious Body distributed.
- Attendance
 - Anyone interested in attending a weekday Mass should contact the parish office to sign up (SG: 773-2511; HT: 773-2380)
 - Attendance is limited to 8
 - If there are less than 8 scheduled for a Mass, walk-ins will be welcome on a first come basis.

VOLUNTEERS NEEDED AT COMMUNION SERVICES

3 volunteers are needed at each communion service to assist with the process

- Monitor the communion line and maintain a safe number in church.
- Take temperatures with a forehead thermometer.
- Monitor the parking lot and direct people arriving and leaving.

Additional Responsibility (Detailed instruction will be provided):

- Sanitize doors, railings and other contact areas immediately after communion service.

No Catholic is required to attend Mass and to receive Holy Communion during the pandemic. The permission to do so is for those who desire to receive Holy Communion and can safely do so.
